Outdoor Preschool Storytime

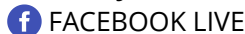

Sundays at 12PM | Sept 12 & 26

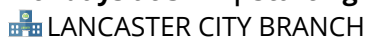


Wild about Minecraft? Come build with us! Experienced builders and first-time players are welcome to join us in game or on Twitch!

Let's Draw Together

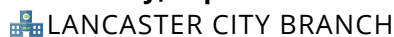
Wednesday, September 15 at 4PM

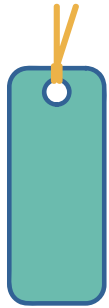
